




<p>With its massive sails the <b>Eagle Class Battleship</b> is one of the most imposing, and elegant, sailing ships in the <b>Uncharted Seas</b>. With its massive broadsides this ship can lay down devastating fire, able to cripple most vessels easily in <b>Range Bands 1 to 2</b>. Its fore guns are capable and a <b>4/3/1</b> cannon rating at the aft should make smaller ships think about sneaking behind this impressive vessel. A well built hull gives the <b>Eagle</b> a <b>DR</b> rating of <b>6</b> and a <b>CR</b> rating of <b>11</b> and with <b>8 HPs</b> this Battleship can hold its own for long periods of sustained combat.</p>			
SHU003	Imperial Humans Hawk Class Cruiser (2)	\$26.00	
<p>They say that imitation is the greatest form of flattery, and when the <b>Hawk Class Cruiser</b> was designed the shipwrights clearly had the <b>Eagle Class Battleship</b> in mind. This vessel can lay down cannon fire to <b>ALL</b> arcs and with a movement rating of <b>9"</b> the Hawk is manoeuvrable and deadly. A Squadron of <b>3</b> can punch out <b>12AD</b> to port and starboard in <b>Range Band 1</b>.</p>

<p>Sleek, fast and functional. These three simple words sum up the <b>Falcon</b>. A workhorse of any <b>Imperial Human Fleet</b>, the <b>Falcon</b> can hold its own in <b>Range Band 1</b>, especially when four vessels combine their fire for <b>10AD</b>.</p>

<p><b>Martyr</b> ships are manned by zealot crews taken from the <b>Imperial Human</b> naval prisons. Given the choice to rot in prison and eventually feel the pinch of the hangman's noose, or sail to greater glory onboard a <b>Martyr</b> ship, many choose to take the path of glory and end their lives in a shower of pieces!</p> <p>Now for the good news: any crewman that survives the explosion of a <b>Martyr</b> ship receives a full pardon and is welcomed into the ranks of the navy with awe. <b>Martyr</b> ships can operate in squadrons of their own, or be placed in amongst other Frigates, sailing forwards to regain their honour.</p>

<p>The marines of the <b>Imperial Human Navy</b> are fierce warriors capable of defending any ship. The role of the Albatross is to move them from one conflict to another, but at sea the Albatross can be used, with its Marines, to intimidate and capture enemy vessels by Boarding them.</p>

<p>So what happens when you take a <b>Hawk</b> and make it even more scary? Answer: it turns into a <b>Vulture Class Heavy Cruiser</b>. At <b>75</b> points this is not a cheap model to have in a fleet, but when you consider that <b>3</b> models can, in <b>Range Band 1</b>, lay down <b>17AD</b> to port and starboard, you can quickly see why this ship is called a <b>Vulture</b>.</p>

<p>The Bone Griffons Battleship may either have 3 Broadside decks, which is the Reaper Class, or it may have 3 Trebuchet decks, which is the Plague class. Whichever class you choose to field, the Bone Griffons Battleship, stained by algae and littered with barnacles from decades beneath the ocean waves, is sure to scare all those unfortunate enough to encounter it.</p>

<p>There is the advantage of versatility with the Bone Griffons Cruiser similar to that shown by the Bone Griffons Battleship. The Bone Griffons Cruiser may be assembled with a sail or a trebuchet. Trebuchets can fire at targets that are <b>not</b> in Line of Sight, and so these new weapons allow the Bone Griffons to deploy some unique and interesting tactics.</p>

<p>Sabre Attack Airships, the most commonly encountered Sky Pirate vessel, circle their prey in graceful arcs, hammering them with fusillades of cannon fire; the shells fired by Sky Pirate weapons resemble shrieking skulls trailing streamers of raw magic. Once the enemy is softened up, the ship will descend, while its crew launch volleys of cruelly hooked boarding pikes known as <i>rutags</i>.</p>

<p>Sky Pirate ships are piloted by mages known as Windjammers, who are experts at gauging and riding air currents and thermals, whether at high or low altitude. This is especially true of the gigantic Khopesh Class Battleships, which can ride low enough to match the manoeuvres of sea craft without missing a step, while at the same time being capable of drifting easily over rocks, shoals and islands. This allows them to strike at targets trapped in confined waters.</p>
